
SNOWBOARDING



AGE GROUP(S)

11 - 13 years of age.

14 - 16 years of age.

Born between February 9, 1995 and February 9, 2001

Athletes must be 11 years of age and cannot be 17 years of age by the first day of the Alberta Winter Games.

ZONE TEAM COMPOSITION

The maximum team size shall be:

8 competitors per zone (# of females 2 # of males 6)

1 coach per zone (either female or male)

2 chaperones per zone (# of females 1 # of males 1)

FILL POLICY

1. The results from the trials will determine a zone team list and a zone alternates list ranked in the finish order of score.
2. Should there be a need to fill, the first opportunity will be provided from the zone alternates list.
3. If there is a need to fill in from outside the zone, the fills shall come from the alternates list with the greatest participation in the trials.
4. Zones 1-4 and 5-8 will be grouped together for the purpose of determining fills.

Fills must be submitted to the Alberta Sport, Recreation, Parks & Wildlife Foundation by **January 9, 2012.**

ELIGIBILITY

Athletes

- Must be an active member of the Alberta Snowboarding Association.
- Athletes will represent the zone of their permanent residence.

ELIGIBILITY, cont'd

Coaches

NCCP Certification—**CSCP Basic Coaching Certification** entry level or a **CBET-Part A (NCCP) and Part B (NCCP)**. A minimum of one (1) member per zone of staff registered as coaches must be fully trained, under the National Coaching Certification Program to at least **CSF Basic Coach Entry Level**. All coaches must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of the Alberta Winter Games.

All coaches must be an active member and in good standing with the Alberta Snowboarding Association (ASA). Coaches must submit a security clearance check to the ASA and may be subject to an interview by board appointed members

Coaches must be in the process of becoming a certified CSCP Basic Coach and have complete the CSCP on-snow Basic Coach workshop.

AFFILIATION

- All athletes must be registered with the Alberta Snowboarding Association and hold a current membership. Alberta Snowboarding Association 1-403-247-5609 or www.albertasnowboarding.com

PROVINCIAL GAMES REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All zone team competitors, who qualify to compete at the 2012 Alberta Winter Games (excluding coaches and chaperones), are required to pay an individual registration fee of **\$40.00**. This fee will go towards offsetting the costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment and sport competitions. This fee must accompany the athlete's registration form for the Provincial Games.

Please note that the registration deadline for Snowboarding is **January 9, 2012**.

EVENT(S)

All athletes will compete in both slopestyle and banked slalom

- Slopestyle - Two (2) runs, best run scores.
- Banked Slalom - Two (2) runs, best run score

PROTEST PROCEDURES

ENTRY AND ZONE PLAYOFF PROCEDURES

- Qualification will be determined from zone ASA sanctioned events prior to the cut off date for athlete participation. Zone qualification locations and dates to be determined.
- Entry fees for these events are to be determined. Alberta Winter Games entry fees are due at the time of qualification. Event registration will be through the ASA office. Event location may change at the discretion of the ASA.
