Request for refund must be submitted by email to: events@albertasnowboarding.com The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event – must be confirmed with a doctor's note.
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of Alberta Snowboard Associations Executive Director Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque. Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.
