Athletes will compete in the following age categories **U13**, U15, U18, and Open for both gender categories.

THE RESORT

Located in Calgary, Alberta, Winsport is the home of the 1988 Winter Olympics and is a world class training facility for numerous sports. With excellent snowmaking abilities, Winsport is able to build quality jumps for the Slopestyle athletes and numerous courses for riders of all abilities.
