ONLINE REGISTRATION ONLY - NO DAY OF REGISTRATION PERMITTED

Online registration for all competitions will close on February 20, 2025.

Registration is limited to 25 women and 60 men athletes.

Eligibility - FIS Competitions

Competitors must be 13 years of age as of December 31, 2025.

Athletes must be active, members in good standing with their member club, Alberta Snowboarding and Snowboard Canada in advance of event registration. ALL competitors MUST hold a valid FIS License before the first Team Captains Meeting (TCM).



All athletes must be represented at all relevant Team Captains Meetings.

Canadian athletes can purchase Provincial/Territorial Advanced Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license online under Member Services [HERE](#).

International Athletes Notice

To confirm registration, the Event Organizers MUST receive a written confirmation/entry from the athlete's National Snowboard Association confirming that they are in good standing, prior to arrival at the event. The confirmation letter must be submitted by email to:

Registration Fees

The cost is **CAD \$200** per event.

For all three events, **CAD \$500**.

Lift Tickets

Athletes: CAD \$57.00 (plus tax) per day, purchased at guest services

Coaches: CAD \$57.00 (plus tax) per day, purchased at guest services

Lift ticket purchase is required for all training and competition days. Resort's liability waivers must be completed on the first day of use.
