Alberta Snowboard is proud to host SBX (9th) & Slopestyle (8th) Provincials at Sunridge Ski Area, Edmonton February 8-9, 2025.

Put your learned skills to the test with this fun, low pressure introduction to competition at Sunridge Ski area. A whole weekend of fun, learning and developing skills in slopestyle and snowboard cross (SBX).

Slopestyle will follow a training, qualifying and finals format, with SBX a full morning or training and bracket heats for the afternoon competition.

The event age categories are as follows:

U13: Ages 7-12 **U15**: Ages 13-14 **U18**: Ages 15-17

Open Category: Ages 18+ Masters Category: Ages 35+

Daily awards concluding competition. Top 3 per gender, per age category, with limited bib draw prizes daily.

The event is sanctioned by Alberta Snowboard.

THE RESORT

The event will be held at Sunridge Ski Area, in the City of Edmonton.

Snowboard Cross will be held on the dedicated season long cross track and slopestyle in their big park. The resort welcomes all athletes and their families for the scheduled events.

Eligibility – AB Snowboard

Competitors must be minimum of 7 years of age.

Athletes must be active, members in good standing with their member club and Alberta Snowboarding, in advance of event registration closing. In addition, athletes aged 18 and under MUST be accompanied by a registered AB Snowboard coach for the 2024/2025 season. Coaches may be asked to provide evidence of valid registration.







All athletes must have a registered coach present. Don't have a coach? Check out our clubs page and connect in with a club in your region!

Athletes are eligible to purchase SAIP insurance should they elect too, so long as they are members in good standing at the event. SAIP insurance is not mandatory.

Registration Fees (exc. lift tickets)

Cost is \$25.00 CAD (Plus fees and taxes) per event.

Lift Tickets

CANWEST passes accepted.

Athlete ticket \$41.00 + Taxes per day.

*** 6-pack passes from Sunridge are NOT valid for use at the event.***

Athletes requiring lift passes for the competition must purchase through Snowreg at the time of event registration.

Waiver

Should a waiver be required to be completed by participants – registered individuals will receive the information to complete the document(s).

REFUND POLICY

Event Registration Fee refunds require the approval of the Executive Director of Alberta Snowboard.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Athletes need to be dressed appropriately for the conditions and have a certified helmet on at all times, as per Canada Snowboard Helmet Policy for training and competition.

Athletes must be well behaved at all times, and non-compliance with behavior standards will result in sanction and non-participation.

All athletes must have fundamental snowboard skills, athletes not deemed to have the appropriate skills may be removed from the competition.
