## Eligibility

Competitors must be 7 years of age as of December 31, 2025.

This event is open to club and non-club members. Non-club members must purchase a 'limited membership' with Alberta Snowboard, in order to meet eligibility. Limited memberships are valid for one (1) competition per season ONLY.

Club registered athletes must be active members in good standing with their member club, PTSA and Snowboard Canada in advance of event registration.

All athletes regardless of their membership type are subject to their participation based on skill and behavior. ANY athlete which is deemed to not be aligned with the skills required for the competition level, will be removed from the field of play for all participants safety.

All athletes must be represented at all Team Captains' Meetings – NO exceptions, roll call will occur. Athletes under 18 MUST have a parent or legal guardian represent at the TCM. Only registered, licensed coaches with their PTSA/Canada Snowboard are able to make comments, considerations and request amendments to the program at TCM meetings.

## Lift Tickets

Marmot Basin has a strict no uphill or walking policy. To access viewing areas, you must ski or snowboard and have a valid lift ticket.

**Competitors and Spectators:** Tickets may be purchased at the Marmot Ticket Sales Windows (lower chalet parking lot) Marmot Basin Season Pass Valid for Competition and Canada West passes accepted.



**Best deal:** For season pass holders (from a ski hill with reciprocal agreement) show your ski pass to receive **20% off regular price** (taxes not included)

Competitor registered athletes can get **10% off of regular price.**
